### 8.1 ANTIGUA & BARBUDA PORTS OF ENTRY

- St. John's Deep Water Harbour

### 8.2 HERITAGE QUAY & DEEPWATER BERTHS

### 8.3 CHANNEL

Depth = 25 ft; Width = 300 ft; Length = 8,000 ft.  
Turning Circle = 1,300 ft. Channel is lighted.

### 8.4 PIER

Sheet pile bulkhead containing dredged fill, with concrete slab.  
Length of pier = 1,200 ft.; Apron Width = 35ft.

### 8.5 FACILITIES

Two storey passenger terminal, tropical design.

## 8.6 HERITAGE QUAY

Length of dock = 500 ft.; Depth alongside = 30 ft.  
Required draft alongside = 26 ft. Turning circle = 1,400 ft. in diameter.  
Berthing capability = 2 average cruise ships.  
2 moorings dolphins – 200 ft. apart, creating extension of berthing capability.

## 8.7 HARBOUR DUES

(All prices are in Eastern Caribbean Dollars EC\$).

### For first 72 hours or part thereof:

2,000 and up to 10,000 NRT	\$200.00
Over 10,000 NRT	\$300.00

### For every 24 hours or part thereof after first 72 hours:

2,000 and up to 10,000 NRT	\$100.00
Over 10,000 NRT	\$250.00

### Ships anchored off Antigua:

2,000 and up to 10,000 NRT	\$170.00
Over 10,000 NRT	\$340.00

### Pilotage (each way)

2,000 to 4,000 NRT	\$150.00
4,000 to 6,000 NRT	\$300.00
6,000 to 8,000 NRT	\$300.00
8,000 to 10,000 NRT	\$300.00
10,000 to 12,000 NRT	\$300.00
Maximum	\$450.00

N.B. Overtime After 6:00 pm and before 6:00 am Monday to Saturday and all day Sunday and Public Holidays.

## 8.8 TOWERAGE CHARGES

**Under 500 tons GRT** **\$200.00**

- (a) For berthing or unberthing  
500 tons GRT to 2,000 tons GRT  
Over 2,000 tons GRT

### (b) Clearing hawse at any anchorage

Up to 1,000 tons GRT	\$100.00
Over 1,000 tons GRT	\$150.00

(c) Vessels requesting assistance traversing channel at 50%.

(d) Hourly rate per tug for any other purpose \$650.00 minimum ½ hour.

N.B. Overtime rates of plus 25% of a, b and c apply for any service after 4:00 p.m. and before 8:00 a.m. Monday through Friday all day Saturday and Sunday and all Public Holidays.

Overtime rates of any towing service: as in a, b, c or d – plus 25%.

## **8.9 MOORING AND UNMOORING**

Mooring and unmooring any ship alongside any wharf, quay or jetty mooring buoys or alongside any other ship within a harbour for each service:

Under 1,000 tons GRT	\$ 50.00
1,000 tons to 5,000 tons GRT	\$100.00
5,000 tons GRT	\$200.00

## **8.10 BASIN SML**

Overtime (times as shown) – plus 25%.

## **8.11 FRESH WATER**

From Government - \$50.00 per thousand gallons (APUA)

## **8.12 BUNKERING**

Marine Gas Oil available and can be supplied to ships by tank, trucks or Barge

Two 2,00 h.p. twin screw tugs approved by American Bureau Shipping, Harbour Tugs  
Bollard pull 50,000 tons forward 32,000 aft.

A variety of merchandise available at Heritage Quay. Also located next to Heritage Quay is the Vendors Mall, opened November 2001.
